On the occasion of the International Human Rights Day, Sarajevo Open Centre is honoured to invite you to the conference that will take place on 10 December 2018 in Sarajevo, in the conference room of the Hotel Courtyard by Marriott, address Skenderija 1.

Conference **Peer Violence based on Diversity – Exchange of Experience** is a half-day conference in scope of which there will be talk about strategies to combat bullying - peer violence. Sarajevo Open Centre has, in the previous year, tackled the issue of peer violence based on gender, with the support of the German Embassy in BiH (German Cooperation). We organize this conference with the aim to talk about the issues that children who differ, on basis of gender identity, from the majority of their peers, face, and to present good practices of struggle against bullying that have been developed by certain institutions and NGOs from BiH.

The panelists include representatives of the competent authorities that deal with the topic of bullying in a devoted and systematic way. During the conference, we will present results of the research on bullying on grounds of gender, “Peer Violence based on Diversity – Experience and Recommendations”, the author being Slobodanka Dekić.
